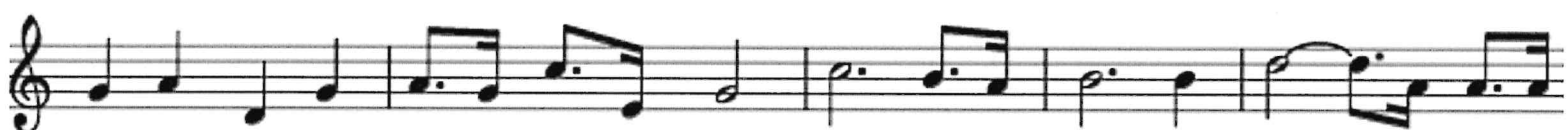

*\*(looking at MARY)\**

**MARY**

*\*(taking JOSEPH's hand)\**

Joseph, I have news that's too wonderful to share alone.

*(pauses, gathering courage)*

I'm going to have a baby... the Son of God.

**JOSEPH**

*(stunned)*

A child? But... how?

**MARY**

*(earnestly)*

The angel told me. I know it sounds unbelievable...

*(voice softens)*

But the Lord told me this is our destiny.

**JOSEPH**

*(processing the news)*

With God and each other, we can face anything. We must go to Bethlehem.

*(The VILLAGERS watch, murmuring with excitement and curiosity.)*

**VILLAGER 3**

*\*(enthusiastically)\**

Have you heard they're going to Bethlehem?

**VILLAGER 4**

\*(gasping)\*

I wonder if we should follow them?

\*(MARY and JOSEPH look at each other, ready for the journey ahead.)\*

**MARY**

\*(confidently)\*

We'll face whatever comes together.

**JOSEPH**

\*(squeezing her hand)\*

Then let's not waste another moment. We must go!

\*(The music begins to swell again as the VILLAGERS start to join in, singing with more energy.)
